Shanti: All right, boss! Yes, boss! Sorry, boss!

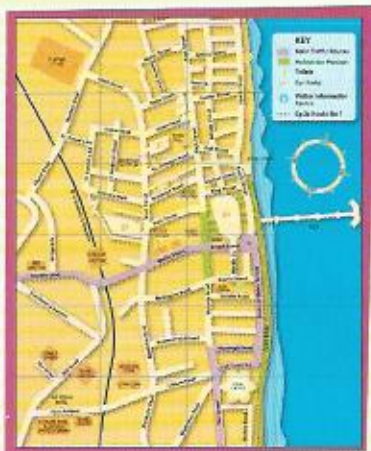
Oliver: Very funny! Alwena, don't forget the group photo this afternoon at 3!
