Okay... Number 5: Prefects have to be punctual.

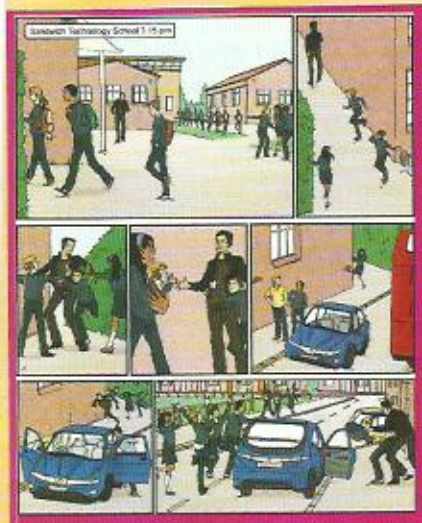
Number 6: Prefects are allowed to fight if necessary.

Story time

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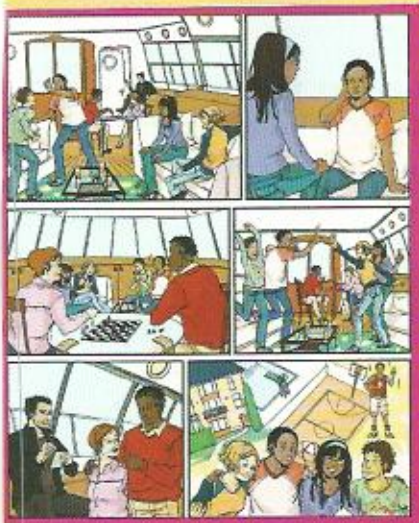
① **Jim:** Wow! What an adventure, huh?
