



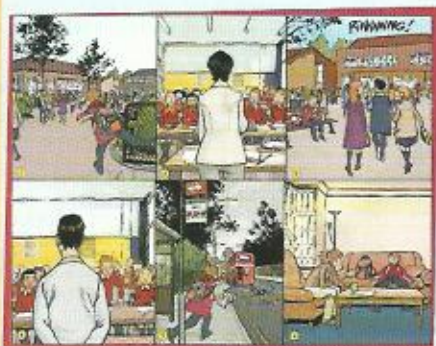

Chrissie: Yes, I have! I've got a monkey! My little brother!

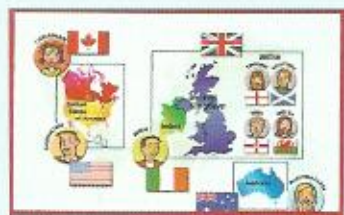
