Rachel: Look at you, Max! You need some fresh air... Come on! Get ready!

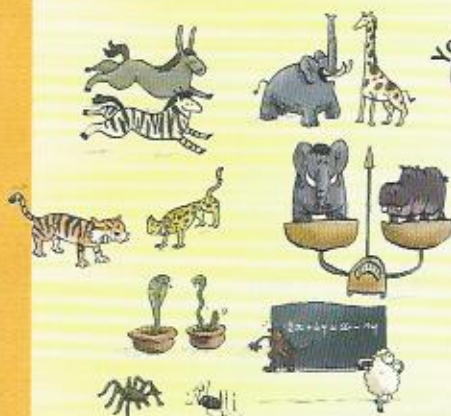

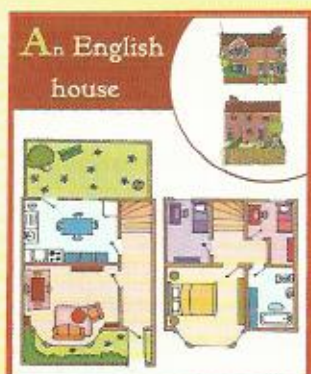

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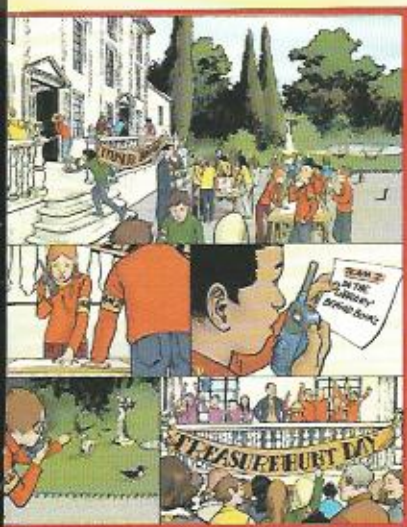
